2. We have a person on the committee/board dedicated to an all-female recruitment program.	No	Find someone suitable using tips from the 'Finding a Female Coordinator' info sheet and invite them to your committee/board meeting.

3. We know what competition we want to enter the team into.	No	Find out more about the location competition by contacting the association. Suggestion: start with a junior girls' team in the lowest age group or a social competition.

4. We have a coach in mind who has a current accreditation willing to coach the team.	No	Identify a suitable person, ideally a qualified and capable coach who understands the needs of coaching females. Approach them and involve them in the implementation phase.

5. Adding a female team to our club is on the agenda to discuss at the next meeting, we know what will be discussed.	No	a) Download 'Your Club's Environment – Female Friendly Checklist.' b) Download the 'Marketing Plan for Female Cricket.' c) Distribute to committee and complete at the next meeting.

6. We know about the population that surrounds our club (demographics, schools, income) that we can use to identify where females can come from.	No	Visit the <a href="#">Moreland City Council Website</a> – demographics and data page for statistics around your club. <a href="#">2016 Census</a> information is also useful.

7. We have contacted the state sporting association seeking advice/help/resources/school clinic/grants.	No	Make contact and ask them to attend a committee meeting to help you get your team up and running.
